If you have a designated route to work on I can make arrangements to give you and your group the Clean Communities Packet.

Rules/regulations:

- The leader of each organization **MUST** return completed paperwork, including tax ID number, to receive consideration with your application. If you're a returning group, w-9 should be on file with township treasurer.
- Five-person minimum. The more the merrier, and have FUN!
- Be prepared to do a minimum of a 1-mile stretch, both sides.
- **20% of your members should be Alloway Township residents.** State program open to all who meet criteria.
- You will be required to take your trash/recyclables to the Alloway Convenience Center, (39 Thomas Road) for disposal: (Hours: Wednesday 1-4:30pm/ Saturday/Sunday 9am to 4:30 pm) A scale is available from Custodian. Once you check in, find a good place to sort and weigh your trash and recyclables. Please be considerate of others. A summary sheet is provided for you to complete and submit.
- Each participant must complete/sign Release and Hold Harmless agreement: parents/guardians to sign for minors. A Certificate of Insurance would be beneficial, but not required.
- Photos are welcome to show off your hard work!

Each organization will receive a mini- grant for their participation. (Amount to be determined)

In this packet, I have enclosed following items:

1. Recycling & Disposal Agreement-RETURN if interested for consideration

2. Release and Hold Harmless form
3. Summary Sheet form
4. Supply List

Please contact me when you get this so I can answer any questions, and thank you for reading all the rules and regulations. This is a fun and great learning program. First come first serve with the grant money, as there are other aspects of this program, including enforcement/education that require increased funding.
