Discussion-

Old business:

- Pierson Property at lake- perhaps a good change for the health of the lake?
- JM & CK still planning on visiting the farm on Commissioners Pike (B26, L6) regarding possibly using bad farming practices.

New business:

- Committeeman Patrick visited FP at his home regarding a possible sewage leak into the Alloway Creek tributary off of Watson Mill Road. There was a complaint by resident Mr. Donovan which was then reported to the Salem County Dept of Health and the NJ DEP. There was some discussion regarding this topic and it was resolved that Autumn will ask the S.C.H.D. About the results of the investigation.
