Announcements/ Correspondence:

- Spotted Lanternfly continues to spread throughout the area. It has been found in Penns Grove. Flyers (please see attachments) will be provided in the municipal building to alert residents.
- Ash Lane Farms - letter of application of permit to continue to use sludge on the farm. ATEC received results of the test wells in the area in the past, but no one can recall seeing those results in the past few years.

Discussion-

Old business:

- ERI - CK made updates to his write up & provided a checklist. He then suggested we do the reports one sheet at a time (tax map sheets) instead of block by block.
 - Sheet 5 includes block 18, 19, 20, 21. Tax maps can be found on the Township website under 'tax assessor'.
 - We need to create a source materials page for the end of our ERI.
 - Lost resources should be added to the updated ERI.
 - There seems to be some trouble accessing the Google Doc for some. RW will double check that everyone has access. We'll finish block 18, then move on to completing the reports by sheet.
 - Each person should have a specific set of things that they handle for the report - to be discussed later.
- RW reported that there is no construction official checklist template available through ANJEC. There have been no reports from Mr. Hoglen to the AT Planning Board. There may be an ordinance through ANJEC that may be helpful to us. - tabled until next meeting.
