- Giordano Recycling: The forum was well attended. CK stated that the Environmental Commissions had the most impactful statements. SCIA stated at the forum that they would not have accepted the Giordano garbage. One person at the event spoke in favor of the facility. Discussion regarding non-Salem County trash ensued. Gloucester paid SCIA \$2M in 2020. Further discussion tabled until June.
- Environmental Science Awards DD sent to the science teacher. Posters due June 1st.
- Cell Tower EIS JM requested a copy of the EIS from the PB & the clerk. The 74 page EIS was
 provided. In the future, we are hopeful that communication between the Environmental
 Commission and the Planning Board will be more open.
