This one day, statewide initiative aims to mobilize the prevention community and raise awareness for the dependency on prescription pain medicine and its link to heroin abuse. Volunteers are asked to disperse door hangers in their community to help share this valuable information with their neighbors. Alloway Township School sent door hangers home with 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Door hangers were also provided to the Strang School at Ranch Hope.
  - Violence Awareness Week was celebrated 10/15/18-10/19/18. Detective Edwin Torres from the NJ Juvenile Justice Commission

conducted a presentation with 8<sup>th</sup> grade students on 10/18/18 regarding gang awareness, drug prevention, and positive decision making skills.
