

At 5:05 p.m. the Regular Meeting of the Alloway Township Finance Committee was called to order by K. Myrle Patrick, Mayor. The meeting was advertised in the South Jersey Times in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231.

Clerk Cheeseman distributed the Bill List which was reviewed by the Committee. With there being no questions, the approval sheet for the Bill List was signed.

The draft agenda for the June 21, 2018 Township Committee meeting was distributed by the Clerk and the Clerk reviewed the items with the Committee. Discussions ensued. It was the consensus of the Committee that all agenda items listed except for items 8 and 11 remain on the agenda for consideration at the June 21, 2018 meeting.


Committeeman Morgan stated he went to the Public Lake Access a couple of times when police were called out. Mayor Patrick stated that the camera is being moved and trucks are doing wheelies. Clerk Cheeseman stated that the portable unit has not been vandalized as yet. Deputy Mayor Reilly said drivers continue to speed on E. Canal Street. It was the consensus of the Committee to instruct Clerk Cheeseman to authorize Township Engineer to conduct a traffic count on E. Canal Street.

Committeeman Morgan and Deputy Mayor Reilly received a couple of complaints from residents pertaining to chickens and horses. She said the Township doesn't have an Ordinance, therefore, she will address the issues with the Planning Board.

Committeeman Morgan said that there is a sinkhole by the school and a couple were found at a ditch on E. Main Street. Public Works Foreman, Laing is looking into this further. The Township Engineer provided a map to the Committee of the area and noted that the ditch is a wetland.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, on motion by Reilly, seconded by Morgan, the meeting was adjourned at 5:47 p.m.
