

The Regular Meeting of the Alloway Township Committee of the Township of Alloway, County of Salem was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal/Senior Citizen Building in accordance with the Annual Notice adopted January 2, 2019, advertised in the South Jersey Times and the Elmer Times, posted in the Alloway Township Post Office and the Municipal Clerks Foyer in compliance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231.

The meeting was called to order by Deputy Mayor K. Myrle Patrick, followed by the flag salute.

Roger Garrison, of Ranch Hope opened the meeting in prayer.

Deputy Mayor Patrick asked for a motion to open public session and anyone wishing to speak, should stand, approach the microphone, state their name and where they reside, and briefly in five (5) minutes or less state your comments to the Township Committee.

On motion by Morgan, seconded by Patrick, public session was opened.

Joe Quather, 61 E. Main Street, requested that the Township look into purchasing movable radar speed limit signs. He noticed vehicles traveling 50-60 mph on E. Main Street and said the speeding mainly occurs around 3:40 pm when the workers from the Island get done work.

He said the signs cost about \$3,000 each. Deputy Mayor Patrick said the Committee made a request to the County to have similar signs installed on Main Street. Committeeman Morgan stated the Township did purchase a mobile speed limit sign and it has been placed on various roads in the Township. Discussion ensued. Mr. Quather requested the Committee contact the State Police to have them do some enhanced enforcement.

Additionally, Mr. Quather referred to information provided in the May 16, 2019 meeting minutes and challenged the Committee's 2% salary increase. He stated that in comparing this year's salary amount with the previous year's amount, the Committees increase is 23.6%. Deputy Mayor Patrick explained the increase covers the salary cut from 8¹/₂ years ago when the Township was in very difficult financial times. Discussion ensued. Mr. Quather requested the Committee to consider rescinding the ordinance and revising the budget to put their increase back to 2%; comparable to what the road department and the rest of the Township employees received. Deputy Mayor Patrick said they will discuss it.

Deputy Mayor Patrick seeing no one wishing to speak asked for a motion to close the public session.

On motion by Morgan, seconded by Patrick, public session was closed.

ORDINANCE NO. 519

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 516 FIXING THE COMPENSATION
FOR CERTAIN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ALLOWAY
IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM

BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Alloway that the salaries and compensation of officers and employees of the Township shall be in accordance with the following schedule and regulations:

Section 1. As of January 1, 2019, the annual salaries and compensation for the hereinafter named officers and employees shall be as follows, and shall be payable in semi-monthly installments:

SEWER MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

Sewer Collection System Operator

\$8,200.00 PER ANNUM SEMI-MONTHLY
