

At 5:00 p.m. the Regular Meeting of the Alloway Township Finance Committee was called to order by P. Ed McKelvey, Mayor. The meeting was advertised in the South Jersey Times and the Elmer Times in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231.

#### PUBLIC SESSION

There being no one in the audience, a motion was made by Patrick and seconded by Morgan to close Public Session.

Vote: All in favor

Clerk Cheeseman distributed the Bill List and with there being no questions or comments, the approval sheet for the Bill List was signed. Discussion ensued briefly regarding Salaries, Capital and Sewer funds for 2020.

The draft agenda for the February 20, 2020 Township Committee meeting was distributed by Clerk Cheeseman. There were no questions regarding the agenda items.

Mayor McKelvey shared a letter he received with the Committee from the Fredon Township Mayor, John Flora. The letter provided information pertaining to how the voters/taxpayers lost their right to approve the school budget when the School Board Election was moved (8 years ago) to the General Election (November). He requested support from New Jersey elected officials and representatives to move the School Board Election back to April...to return this local right. Discussion ensued and the Township Committee is in favor of the School Board Election being moved back to April. Mayor McKelvey instructed Clerk Cheeseman to contact Mayor Flora.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, on motion by Patrick, seconded by Morgan, the meeting was adjourned at 5:50 p.m.
