

At 5:05 p.m. the Regular Meeting of the Alloway Township Finance Committee was called to order by P. Ed McKelvey, Mayor. The meeting was advertised in the South Jersey Times and the Elmer Times in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231. Pursuant to the State of New Jersey COVID-19 Compliance Protocol, the meeting was held in-person with limited seating in the meeting room at the Municipal Building.

The flag salute was led by Mayor McKelvey.

Roll Call - Present: Morgan, Patrick, McKelvey
Municipal Clerk/Administrator, Charlet Cheeseman CMFO/QPA, Bette Jo Pigliacelli and Treasurer, Lois Yarrington were also in attendance.

PUBLIC SESSION

On motion by Patrick, seconded by Morgan, the public session was opened and Mayor McKelvey called for any questions or comments from the public.

Ms. Eduardo, 218 Waterworks Road, attended the meeting to ask the Committee questions pertaining to connecting to the Townships sewer line. Discussion ensued and it was the consensus of the Committee for this property to be connected; however, with discussing the matter further, there are new questions the Committee has for the Township Engineer. Mayor McKelvey told Ms. Eduardo that they will have answers at June's meeting. She thanked the Committee.

There being no further comments from the public, a motion was made by Patrick and seconded by Morgan to close Public Session.

CFO Pigliacelli reviewed the Treasurers Report (Cash Report)

Clerk Cheeseman asked the Committee if they wanted to continue receiving the subscription to the NJLM magazine and the Committee stated they were not interested.

The following was discussed:

- 2021 Oil & Stone Program: The Committee agreed to the following roads: Base Bid will include Earnest Garton, Brickyard, Dorrell, Pierson and East Canal from Greenwich St. to the lake entrance or to the new paving. Alt. Bid will include Elkington Rd. Clerk Cheeseman will need to get specifications from CPWM Michlasavage for East Canal Street portion.

The Committee members had no revisions for April's meeting minutes.

DISCUSSION/CORRESPONDENCE:

1. Cobbs Mill Estates HOA: Request for 2 street lights on Kristine Court. Discussion ensued and the Committee agreed this needs to be looked into further. Therefore, no decision was made.
2. Marijuana/Cannabis: The Planning Bd. adopted Resolution 2021-06 at their meeting held on 5/12/2021 supporting Twp. Committee's decision to "Opt-Out" of the sale etc. of Marijuana. The Twp. Solicitor revised the Ordinance for Introduction at May's meeting

3. Election Resolutions from Pennsville and Salem City: Clerk Cheeseman explained the Resolution to the Committee. Discussion ensued. Mayor McKelvey instructed Clerk Cheeseman to add Resolution to the upcoming meeting for consideration.
4. NJ DOT Announcement for accepting Municipal Aid Grant Applications—due by 7/1/2021. Discussion ensued. The Committee agreed there's no need to apply at this time.
5. Reopening the Municipal Building: Discussion ensued and it was the consensus of the Committee to reopen. However, no date was decided upon and the Committee wants to talk to the Township Solicitor to make sure the Township is in compliance.

Committeeman Morgan asked if there was an update on the animal situation at 461 Alloway-Friesburg Road. Discussion ensued. Clerk Cheeseman will contact Animal Control Officer for an update.

Committeeman Morgan addressed Mayor McKelvey and Deputy Mayor Patrick that he wants to pursue the Township again regarding the wall on his property breaking when the emergency pipeline was installed. Discussion ensued.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, on motion by Patrick, seconded by Morgan, the meeting was adjourned at 6:43 p.m.
