

ALLOWAY TOWNSHIP FINANCE COMMITTEE

MAY 16, 2022

At 5:00 p.m. the Regular Meeting of the Alloway Township Finance Committee was called to order by P. Ed McKelvey, Mayor. The meeting was advertised in the designated newspapers in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231.

The flag salute was led by Mayor McKelvey.

Municipal Clerk/Administrator, Charlet Cheeseman, CMFO/QPA, Bette Jo Pigliacelli via phone, Township Treasurer, Lois Yarrington was in attendance.

PUBLIC SESSION

There being no one in the audience, a motion was made by Patrick and seconded by Morgan to close Public Session.

The Township Committee members reviewed the bill list and with no one having any questions, the approval sheet for the Bill List was signed.

CMFO Pigliacelli explained the Resolution regarding the Township changing their financial institution and will be effective July 1, 2022. Also, since the Committee is proceeding with the 2022 Oil & Stone Program, she will prepare the Ordinance appropriating the funds.

The following was discussed:

1. Review of specifications for 2022 Oil & Stone Bid Package: Coleman Road
2. Lake Access Proposal: Committee approved Krise Electric for light fixtures (\$6,449.56)
3. Paradise Road: Committee authorized Fralinger Engineering to do survey (\$800)
4. Ordinance to revise wage range of position of Deputy Clerk/Deputy Registrar
5. Clerk's office: ideas to make more secure
6. Municipal Alarm System: A new panel box needed (\$200)
7. NJDOT FY 2023 State Aid Program: Committee agreed to apply for Section IV of Pierson Road
8. Renewal of Emergency Management Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement: Committee agreed to renew the agreement
9. Public Land Auction on Undersized Lots: Assessor provided fair market value for each lot the Committee wants included in the auction.... Committee decided on their own minimum dollar amount. Clerk has questions for the Solicitor
10. 74 N. Greenwich Street: An informal review of the property was on the May 11th Planning Boards meeting agenda. Committeeman Morgan, Planning Board Liaison attended the meeting & told the Committee there is an interested buyer
11. Lake Access: Rose Rugosa bushes scheduled to be planted May 21, 2022

The Committee members had no revisions for April's meeting minutes. Clerk Cheeseman also reviewed the upcoming items on the agenda and no one had any questions.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, on motion by Patrick, seconded by Morgan, the meeting was adjourned at 6:05p.m.
