**PUBLIC SESSION:** There was no one in the audience.

**FINANCE ITEMS:**

The Township Committee members reviewed the bill list and with no one having any questions, the approval sheet for the bill list was signed.

Clerk Cheeseman received the agreement from the shredding company and set the date for the event to be held on October 14 from 9-11am. She also informed them that Quinton Township has been having serious issues with their pump stations and Quintons CFO will be sending over purchase orders. Additionally, the submission for the 2022 audit was extended, therefore, that resolution will be on September's meeting agenda.

There were no updates on the following: Host Community Benefits Agreement; 4-way stop signs in center of town; Lots in Penton Station; Junkyard matter; Dirty Jersey Tavern in regards to sewer connection; NJDEP Stormwater upgrade.

The Committeemen gave updates on the following: Process for the Township to gain access to the front of the pump station began; Oil & Stone Road program began today and will be done at the end of day tomorrow; Pierson Road Section III was paved and need to complete a few items; the process for the tax sale certificates/foreclosures began.

**CORRESPONDENCE:**

1. Inquiry regarding HOA lots: Discussion ensued and the Township may have to contact the Planning Board Attorney for advice.
2. Twp. Historian Coordinators request to revive the Historical Committee. Discussion ensued and the Committee agreed that they wouldn't want property owner's rights to be infringed upon. They will share their suggestion at the upcoming meeting.
3. County's Broadband request availability: The Committee has no knowledge of what is available.
4. Salem County Engineer: Discussion ensued regarding the recent "Support" resolution being returned to the township as incomplete.
5. Alloway Township Fire Company: Request township to replace (3) emergency light units and informed the Committee that Chris Hagan resigned as President and Rick Weisgerber is the Interim President. Their special election is on August 29<sup>th</sup>.
6. Alloway Township Ambulance: A digital sign board was installed. The Townships Tech visited the hall to service their computers. Squad Captain requested a quote from Dell for 2 computers and monitors.
