

At 5:00 pm the Regular Meeting of the Alloway Township Finance Committee was called to order by Chuck Angelus, Deputy Mayor. The meeting was advertised in the designated newspapers in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231. The flag salute was led by Deputy Mayor Angelus.

PUBLIC SESSION: Motion to open Public Session was made by Committeeman Ledy, seconded by Deputy Mayor Angelus

BILL LIST:

The Township Committee members reviewed the Bill List. With no other questions or comments, the approval sheet for the Bill List was signed.

FINANCE ITEMS:

OLD BUSINESS/UPDATES:

- Oil and Chip Road List- The committee the reviewed the list of roads proposed by the Mayor's assessment. Deputy Mayor Angelus presented a hybrid list of roads based on the recommendations from Public Works. After some discussion, it was determined that the successful bidder would be responsible for preparing the roads prior to the oil and chip work.

NEW BUSINESS/CORRESPONDENCE:

- 19-1 Truck- Deputy Mayor Angelus agreed with the Finance Department that listing the 19-1 fire truck on GovDeals would be the most effective method for selling it. Committeeman Ledy also recommended listing a loader and backhoe for sale through the same process. The Committee concurred that these items should be prepared for auction and posted.
- Dog Licenses- Second Notice- Deputy Mayor Angelus suggested the second notice for not having your dog licensed be mailed out the first week of July.
- Review Tax Collectors Report for May 2026
- Committeeman Ledy stated he would like to obtain an electronic sign for placement in front of the Township Building to improve communication and provide information to the public. He inquired whether any grant opportunities may be available to help fund the purchase and installation of the sign. Further research into potential funding sources will need to be conducted. This would help comply with the Townships Stormwater guidelines.
- Deputy Mayor Angelus will set up the Alloway Township Facebook page in the near future.

- Chief John Mahala stated the new fire truck responded to its first call on Saturday. Chief Mahala thanked the Committee for their support and for the purchase of the truck.
