**PUBLIC SESSION:** Motion to open Public Session was made by Deputy Mayor Angelus, seconded by Committeeman Leady

There being no public present, a motion to close Public Session was made by Committeeman Leady, seconded by Deputy Mayor Angelus.

**BILL LIST:**

The Township Committee members reviewed the Bill List. With no other questions or comments, the approval sheet for the Bill List was signed.

**FINANCE ITEMS:**

- A discussion was held regarding the future of the Alloway Ambulance Corp and ambulance services for the Township. It was determined that additional discussion is necessary, and the committee will continue to evaluate the matter and develop a proposed solution for consideration.

**OLD BUSINESS/UPDATES:**

- Road Maintenance – The Committee discussed the roads that need to go out to bid for the Oil and Stone Program, it was determined Public Works will work on Plummer Lane to get ready for next year.
- Public Works installed the speed bumps on Canal Street.
- A discussion was held amongst the Committee regarding the Public Works goals list.
- 19-1 Truck/Backhoe/ Loader- Municipal Clerk Dolbow reported that she has a meeting scheduled with GovDeals next week to arrange the Township's 19-1 Truck, Backhoe and Loader to be listed for sale on GovDeals website. She advised that a resolution authorizing the listing and sale of these items through GovDeals will need to be adopted at Thursday's committee meeting.

**NEW BUSINESS/CORRESPONDENCE:**

- Dam Maintenance- Public Works need to maintain the mowing of the Dam. Mayor McKelvey stated that the Municipal Clerk will send a letter to the new property owner of 74 N. Greenwich St requesting permission for Public Works staff to access the property to mow and perform maintenance on the dam.
- Social Media Page- Deputy Mayor Angelus stated that he would work on establishing the Alloway Township Facebook page to provide informational posts for residents.
- The Committee reviewed an email from V-Comm LLC regarding a proposed fiber optic cable installation project. The proposed route includes primarily county roads, along with a limited number of Township roads. After discussion, the Committee directed the Township Engineer to contact V-Comm LLC to review the proposal and coordinate any necessary Township involvement.

The Committee members had no revisions to June 15, 2026 Finance Meeting Minutes or the June 18, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes.
