PUBLIC NOTICE
BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by Township Committee of the Township of Alloway, in the County of Salem, State of New Jersey on April 16, 2026 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A FIRE TRUCK AND RELATED APPARATUS BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF ALLOWAY, IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$750,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$714,285 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COSTS THEREOF
