TAKE NOTICE that Resolution No. 26-08 is entitled: *A Resolution to Affirm the Township of Alloway's Civil Rights Policy with Respect to All Officials, Appointees, Employees, Prospective Employees, Volunteers, Independent Contractors, and Members of the Public That Come into Contact with Municipal Employees, Officials and Volunteers for the County of Salem, State Of New Jersey.*

Resolution No. 26-08 affirms that the Township of Alloway's Civil Rights Policy will be consistent with all applicable civil rights laws and regulations including, but not limited to the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964 as subsequently amended, the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Conscientious Employee Protection Act.

Resolution 26-08 was adopted at Reorganization Meeting by the Township Committee of the Township of Alloway, Salem County New Jersey, in the Municipal Building, 49 South Greenwich Street, Alloway, New Jersey on January 2, 2026 and shall take effect immediately.
