

RESOLUTION
of the Township of Alloway
in the County of Salem, State of New Jersey

**DESIGNATING OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ALLOWAY AND
ESTABLISHING ELECTRONIC PUBLIC NOTICE PROCEDURES**

WHEREAS, the Township of Alloway is required to provide public notice of certain actions pursuant to the “Open Public Meetings Act,” N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., N.J.S.A. 40:53-1, and other applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2025, c.72 authorized municipalities to satisfy statutory public notice requirements through electronic publication on the municipality’s official website, subject to specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee desires to designate an official newspaper and establish procedures for the electronic publication of public notices for calendar year 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Alloway, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1) Designation of Official Online News Publication (January 1, 2026 – February 28, 2026).
From January 1, 2026 through February 28, 2026, *The South Jersey Times* newspaper is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Township for the publication of public notices, when required by law.

2) Transition to Electronic Publication (Effective March 1, 2026).
Effective March 1, 2026, and pursuant to P.L. 2025, c.72, public notices required by law shall be published exclusively by electronic means on the official website of the Township of Alloway, except where publication in a newspaper remains expressly required by statute.

3) Official Internet Website (January 1, 2026 - December 31, 2026).
All electronically published public notices shall be posted in full text on the Township’s official website at www.allowaytownship.com and shall remain accessible to the public in accordance with statutory retention requirements.

4) Municipal Clerk Authorization.
The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to implement electronic public notice procedures, maintain proof of publication, and prepare the bi-monthly public notice postings required for calendar year 2026.

5) Designated Places for Posting Hard Copies.
Additionally, the Township of Alloway designates the bulletin boards in the foyer of the Clerk's Office in the Municipal/Seniors Complex and the Alloway Post Office as a place for posting hard copies of public notices.

6) Repealer.
All resolutions or portions thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
